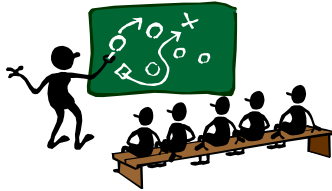


Prom Day Coaches' Clinic Saturday, May 1st, 2010 Granger High School
